

Release Notes for CPS 5.01.1091 - December 2007 (Windows)

Fixed Issues

- The application takes a long time to launch before it becomes usable (launch time has been improved)
- An error is thrown at application launch for non-English languages
- Charting data is not updated after editing a question in the session
- Charting shows the wrong questions when selecting/deselecting questions from more than one session
- Charting throws an error when hiding/showing the charting options if no questions are selected
- Blackboard session uploads could fail with large classes in some cases
- In the Gradebook, the attendance chart would not display if data was missing
- Charting window not always resized correctly
- The option, "show question image after response" was broken
- The link provided to download the newest version of CPS is no longer valid
- Clicking items in the Gradebook can cause an error when using tablet devices (Wacoms, Tablet PCs, etc)
- Attempting to engage a PowerPoint slideshow throws an error
- An error is thrown when attempting to use the update service
- Attempting to open a database stored at a network location throws the error "The current user does not have write access to the selected database."
- Clicking the "Print/Export" button when attempting to print a class will cause an error if the user does not have permission to save to the selected location
- Importing ExamView XML causes CPS to replace commas "," with "CPSCOMMA" in certain situations.
- Special characters ("#", "@", etc) in Lesson Attributes cause an error
- In Charting, Cross Tabulation could not be done if the selection bar was hidden
- When attempting to edit a question's notes and media, the "Question Note" window appears behind the application's main window
- Double clicking a database was not opening it in CPS
- Problem reading ExamView content
- Study Guides were not being uploaded correctly in all cases
- When opening another database from within CPS, the information shown was from the previous database
- Blank answers in Questions are not always saved properly
